SUBJECT INDEX

Stamp issues are listed under the name of the issuing authority, e.g. Southern Rhodesia, or, in the case of BSA Co. issues under the name by which the issue is widely known, e.g. ‘Small Arms’, ‘Double Heads’, etc. In a few cases these entries are repeated under the heading of a particular omnibus issue, e.g. Rhodes Centenary Exhibition. Postage due labels are a separate subject, and are listed under that heading. Revenue stamps, of which there are far fewer issues than issues of postage stamps, are listed under that heading, with the name of the issuing authority as a subheading. Postal stationery is listed in a similar manner, except that air letter cards/aerogrammes are listed separately as these are also of interest to collectors of airmails.

Post offices and postmarks are listed as such, though the majority of the ‘postmarks’ referred to by almost all authors are more accurately described as datestamps. Cancellers, for example barred-oval and barred-diamond types, are listed separately. Problems arise in that the majority of post offices opened prior to the creation of the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland, remained open during Federation and were still open when the individual territories became independent republics. Post offices are therefore listed under the sub-heading of the territory identified by the author concerned, which is usually, but by no means consistently, the name of the territory when the office first opened. There is a further complication in that offices opened during the existence of the Federation should be grouped under that heading, but, as the individual territories retained the names that were extant prior to 1953, most authors have assigned the post offices and datestamps to Southern or Northern Rhodesia or Nyasaland. Postmarks, i.e. datestamps, often continued in use after the name of the territory had changed. Datestamps introduced after Northern Rhodesia became Zambia and (Southern) Rhodesia became Zimbabwe should of course be listed under the name of the republic in question, but since some authors group the datestamps, of for example Southern Rhodesia (pre- and post-Federation), Rhodesia and Zimbabwe, it is not always possible to ‘disentangle’ such listings. A similar situation arises with the post offices and postmarks (datestamps) of BCA and Nyasaland, with the further complication that Tanganyika Province, originally administered as part of BCA, was incorporated into North Eastern Rhodesia, which subsequently became part of Northern Rhodesia, now the Republic of Zambia.

Book reviews are listed in the section headed *Bibliography*. They, together with books and articles mentioned under ‘Bookshelf’, ‘Literature to look for’, ‘Library acquisitions’, and in the

‘Hon. Secretary’s notes’ are, however, also listed under the appropriate subject headings, as this provides useful cross-references to other publications with relevant articles.
