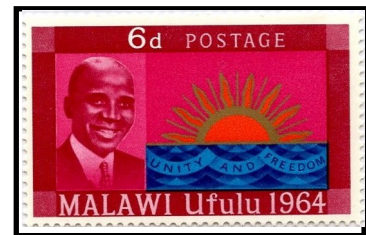


## 1964 - DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE IN MALAWI

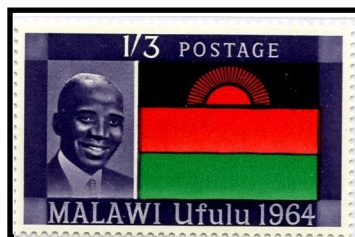
Nyasaland attains independence on 6th July, 1964, when its territorial title changed to Malawi. On this day the "UFULU" issue was released together with the Definitive Issue bearing the new territorial title. Each of the four "UFULU" stamps bear the portrait of Dr. Hastings Banda. "UFULU" in Chichewa means "Freedom".



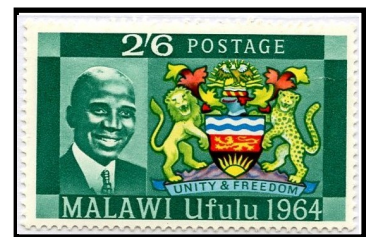
3d Dr H. Banda (Prime Minister) and the Independence Arch
