Preface

Without doubt, *South of the Zambesi* is one of the primary references for anyone interested in Rhodesian and Zimbabwean postmarks. The hard pioneering work was done to produce the original work back in 2003, when postmarks were logically categorised, postmark images obtained and data collected and presented in a clear and concise manner. However, with the huge amount of data required to cover the whole field, it was inevitable that some of that data, particularly the dates when various postmarks were in use, would subsequently be found to have been inaccurate or were not available. Now that the foundation has been laid, it becomes much easier to discover and record more accurate data by comparing with the original records .

For many years there has been a need for a revision of the 2003 edition. That this has not been done is clearly due to the size of the challenge that this involves. The whole work must first be reproduced and digitised so that data can be edited.

This fact is behind the idea to eventually divide *South of the Zambesi* into three parts: -

- PART 1 THE POSTMARKS OF RHODESIA 1888 to 17TH APRIL 1980
- PART 2 THE MACHINE CANCELLATIONS OF RHODESIA 1911 to 17TH APRIL 1980
- PART 3 THE POSTAL CANCELATIONS OF ZIMBABWE FROM 18TH APRIL 1980

In time, the three parts will replace the original 2003 edition. Each can be produced in 'stand-alone' format so that philatelists with a more limited interest may, if they so desire, use only the part/s in which they have an interest. It is hoped that in the future, revisions will be made less arduous by dividing the work into these three sections, each with its own editor/s, but that is for the future.

In compiling this catalogue, which equates to the future Part 2, the opportunity has been taken to add to the data that was included in the 2003 publication. Philatelists interested in this obscure corner of our hobby will now have access to details of the machine slogans and wave patterns in addition to the postmarks. With one exception (Postage Paid, W3b), the same definitions and classifications of the postmarks used in the original work have been used in this catalogue. A simple definition and classification of the wave patterns has been introduced and each slogan has been allocated a number (in alphabetical order) for ease of reference.

In addition to illustrating the circular date stamps, images of each slogan and wave pattern are also shown. Hand Roller marks, whilst not being machine cancellations, are better included in this part than with the hand cancellers.

As with hand cancellers, machine circular date stamps were subject to mutilation, either when the 'S' of 'S. RHODESIA' was removed during the mid-sixties after Northern Rhodesia was renamed Zambia or when 'RHODESIA' was removed altogether during 1979 preparatory to a change in the name of the country. The dates as listed in the study of the 1979 mutilations *The Mutilated Hand Stamps of Rhodesia: January – June 1979* by D.A. Mitchell and H.C. Russell are quoted wherever appropriate and are denoted with an asterisk.

Much of the data included in this catalogue was provided by the author of *South of the Zambesi*, Hal Hoyte. All who collect Rhodesian and Zimbabwean postmarks will benefit from his meticulous records. Comparison has also been made with the slogans listed in *The Postal History of Southern Rhodesia* by E.B. Proud, all of which are included in this catalogue.

Since the publication of the First Edition, more accurate information has been recorded, both as to the dates of use of the circular date stamps, and which slogans were used by each office. In particular, I wish to thank Tony Banks and John McKendrick in this regard.

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INTRODUCTION

How machine postmarks are coded

The codes used to describe machine postmarks are the same as the codes used to describe ordinary postmarks and follow those used in *South of the Zambesi*: -

CDS Types:

- E Blank below, as manufactured. Excludes mutilated cancellers (see below)
- G Town name only below the dateline
- K All postmarks produced on the Krag machine are prefixed K
- U All postmarks produced on the Universal machine are prefixed U
- W All wave pattern types are prefixed W
- R All hand roller cancellations are prefixed R

Presentation of the date:

- r Dateline month in roman numerals
- u Dateline month in figures

Mutilated cancellers

'S'

Until 1964, the name of the country was S. RHODESIA. When Northern Rhodesia gained its independence as ZAMBIA on 24th October 1964, the Southern Rhodesian government announced that the 'Southern' had become redundant, and that the name of the country would henceforth be simply RHODESIA. (This name was never enshrined in law.)

Post Office circular date stamps were altered by removing the 'S', leaving a lopsided 'RHODESIA'. The absence of the 'S', where it has been excised, is denoted with an 'S' underlined, thus 'S'

'SR'

In 1979 the name of the country was again changed, this time to ZIMBABWE RHODESIA. With few exceptions, the Post Office did not use this country name. Instead, it used no country name on the circular date stamps, and the name 'RHODESIA' was removed, leaving a blank below the dateline. The absence of the country name 'RHODESIA' (on postmarks that had originally carried the country name 'S. RHODESIA'), is denoted with an 'SR' underlined, thus 'SR'.

'R'

After 1964, new types of postmarks were introduced with the name 'RHODESIA' centred below the dateline. These postmarks had never carried the 'S' of 'S. RHODESIA', so the absence of the country name 'RHODESIA' where this was removed on these date stamps is denoted with an 'R' underlined, thus 'R'.

Slogans

A unique reference number precedes the description of each slogan. These numbers place the slogans in alphabetical order.

This number is not a part of the slogan, but has been added in order to reference to the slogan more easily.

General comments about dates, colours and scarcity

Dates

Dates marked with an asterisk * are the mutilation dates shown in the publication *'The Mutilated Hand Stamps of Rhodesia, January 1979 – June 1979'* by D.A. Mitchell and H.C. Russell. These dates are the last date with RHODESIA in use and the first date without the use of RHODESIA. However, where *'South of the Zambesi'* shows a date with a later use of Rhodesia or a date with an earlier use without Rhodesia, or where M & R does not provide a date, the *'South of the Zambesi'* dates have been used.

Data about hand roller marks are scarce. Where Mitchell & Russell have provided dates for the mutilation of hand rollers, these have been shown. However, it is quite likely that although some of the smaller post offices possessed rollers which were mutilated, they were never put into use. A date 'Z' indicates that the period/use continued into the Zimbabwe era.

Colours

Krag machine cancellations are black unless otherwise described.

Universal machine cancellations are black unless otherwise described.

All postage paid and postage paid in cash marks, including any slogans used, are red unless otherwise described.

The Bulawayo Returned Letter Office cancellations are red.

Hand Roller marks are black.

Slogans are black except when used in conjunction with Postage Paid cancellations unless otherwise described.

Scarcity

No attempt has been made to evaluate or suggest the rarity of any postmark or cancellation. This is largely a question of judgement and is beyond the scope of this catalogue. Undoubtedly some of the postmarks, and many of the slogans used by the smaller offices, are difficult to come by.

Machine cancellations

The machine is fixed to a table, and letters or cards, which have been placed with their addresses all on the same side and the same way up, are fed into the machine which applies the cancellation.

The canceller die/s is/are shaped around a roller, and the cancellation is rolled onto the letter or card.

Cancelling machines can only deal with letters or cards up to a certain size and thickness. Items exceeding these limits are excluded and are subsequently cancelled with either a hand canceller or with a roller canceller which delivers a cancellation similar in appearance (including a wave pattern) and which may be confused with a Krag machine cancellation.

Machine cancellations normally comprise of two elements:

(a) the CIRCULAR DATE STAMP (CDS) which shows the same data as a hand canceller, ie the P O name, the territory name (optional, not shown on any CDS from 1979 onwards) and the date – day, month, year and (optional) time. (A SQUARE datestamp is known used with machine “Postage Paid” marks from Salisbury) and
(b) the OBLITERATION, which is alongside the CDS and may consist of a wave pattern (refer to the section dealing with WAVE PATTERNS) or a SLOGAN eg “PREVENT VELD FIRES” or a simple drawing or logo. Slogans are used by both Krag (not after 1953) and Universal machines.

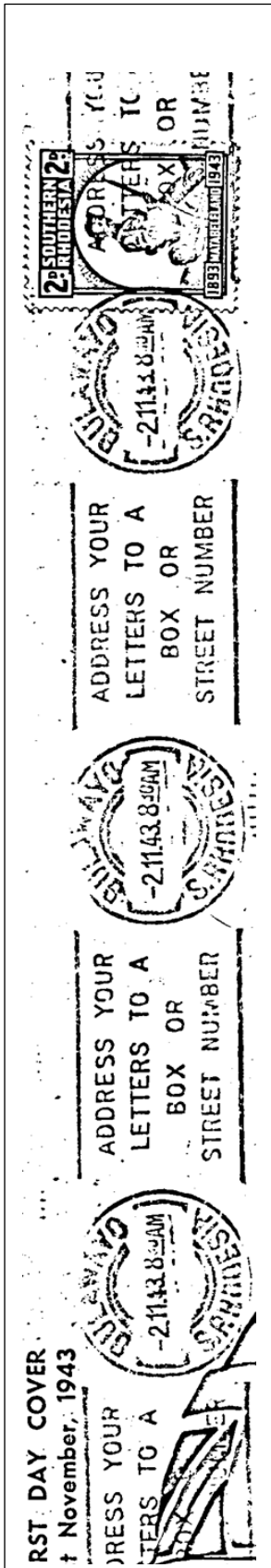
Machine cancellations are best collected complete, showing both the CDS and the obliteration or, in the case of continuous impressions, two of each as will be explained below. However, even part-strikes are collectable – a CDS by itself could yield a date of use, though a slogan by itself is usually less useful if detached from it's CDS, since most slogans were used by more than one post office.

Machine cancelling machines can be divided into **hand operated (Krag machine)** and **electrically driven (Universal machine)**.

Whilst some of the smaller offices only used the hand operated Krag Machine, in many cases this was subsequently replaced with the electrically driven Universal machine which could handle a greater quantity of mail.

Only the main office in Salisbury used both the Krag and Universal machines simultaneously, 1941 – 1945 during WW2.

At left is an image of a Krag machine cancellation illustrating a continuous cancellation on a long envelope.

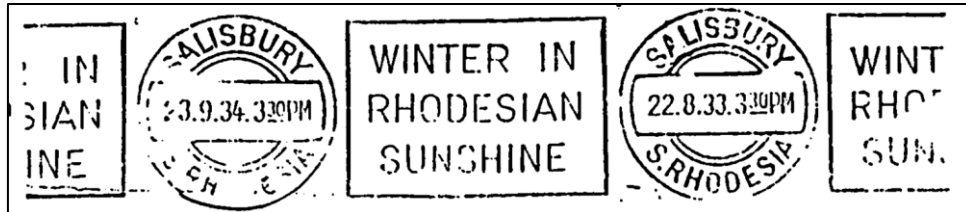

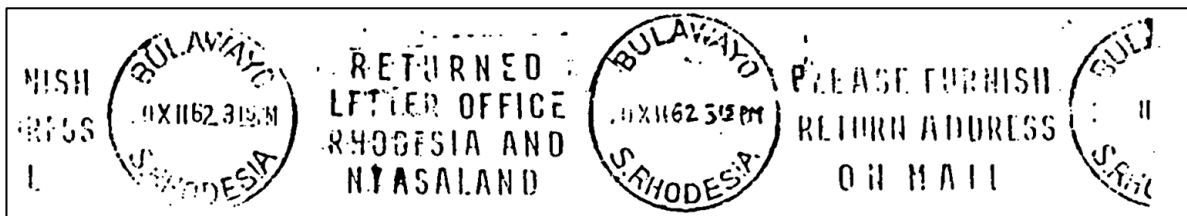
Krag machine

The Krag machine, named after it's manufacturer, is hand operated and applies a continuous cancellation across the top of the envelope or card. A long envelope may have two or more impressions of the CDS. The cancelling roller has two CDS dies alternating with obliteration dies. It was first introduced in 1911 in conjunction with five parallel straight lines (for image see page 11). In 1924 the first slogan appeared, 'SUPPORT RHODESIAN INDUSTRIES'.

An example of two different obliteration dies can be seen on this example from the Returned Letter Office at Bulawayo, one reading RETURNED/LETTER OFFICE/RHODESIA AND/NYASALAND and the other PLEASE FURNISH/RETURN ADDRESS/ON MAIL. Slight differences can also be seen on the CDS impressions, one having taller lettering of S. RHODESIA.

The CDS cancellations on all Krag machines measure 26mm overall diameter, with the date in a single line. All show the PO above, and until 1979, all showed the name of the territory below, with two exceptions – KARIBA (Type K2E, blank below) and WEST END (Type K2Gr, Bulawayo below).

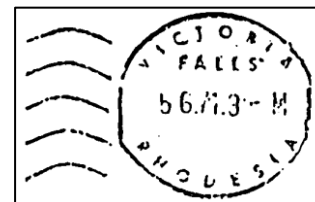

Outer circle single, inner circle replaced by ARCS (DCA) below PO NAME and above "RHODESIA". MONTH in FIGURES and TIME.
K6R (illustrated) is the mutilated version with 'RHODESIA' excised.

Universal machine

The Universal machine was introduced in Salisbury in January 1938. However, it was not until 1946 that another post office received one – Bulawayo. No doubt the delay was due to WW2. It is interesting to note that many offices were given a Krag machine to begin with, which was only used for a short time before being exchanged for a Universal machine.

The basic operation of this machine is similar to that of the Krag machine in that it applies the cancellation by means of a roller die. However, there are two basic differences:

- a) It is electrically powered, so quicker and able to cancel a greater number in a given time, and
- b) It only applies a single impression of the CDS and of the obliteration before kicking the envelope away to receive the next envelope. A very long envelope might receive two impressions when the machine takes the second half of the envelope as a second envelope, as illustrated below

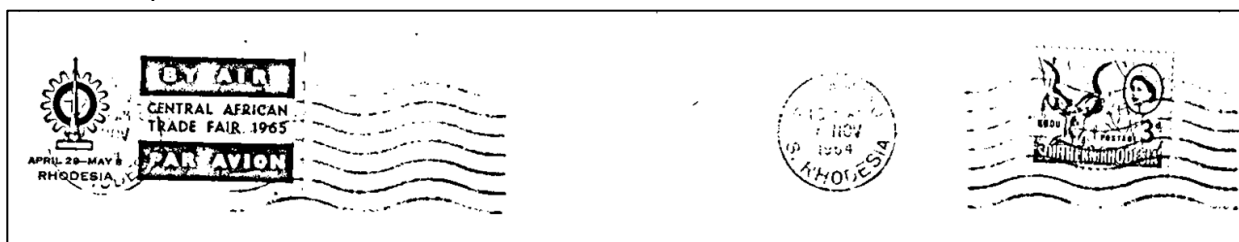


Image (reduced size) showing two impressions on one long envelope.

The CDS cancellations on all Universal machines measure 21mm overall diameter, with PO NAME above and TERRITORY below, except Type U6 which shows an arc in place of the territory name. DATE is displayed in three lines (INSET TYPE) with DAY & MONTH in one line, YEAR in one line and TIME in one line. The order in which these lines appear is changeable and consequently can, in theory, be presented in any one of six different ways. Errors of inversion can occur with any one, two or on all three of the lines. More common is for the whole CDS to be inverted.

The standard *South of the Zambesi* postmark coding system applies:

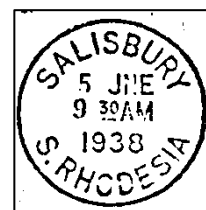
The territory name for types U1 and U2 is S. RHODESIA.

Similarly, the territory name for types U3, U4 and U5 is RHODESIA.

TYPE U1

SINGLE CIRCLE, PO NAME above, S. RHODESIA below.

Medium lettering very similar to U1b below, but the ends of 'S' are more curved. 'A' of 'RHODESIA' is 1½mm wide at the base. This U1 prototype was introduced at Salisbury in 1938.



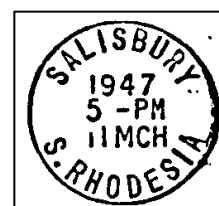
SUB-TYPE U1a

Narrow, squared lettering, not unlike U1e below.

S. RHODESIA more spaced, 18mm across.

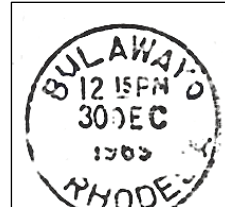

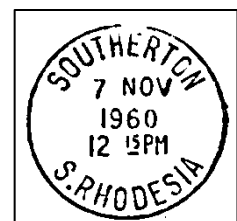

S. RHODESIA measures 16mm across.

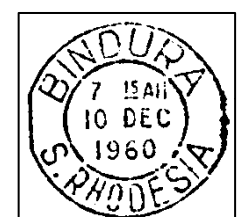

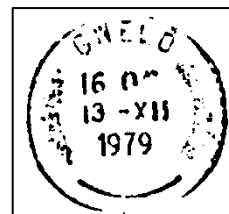

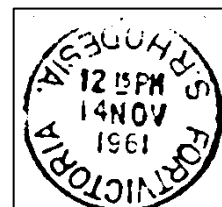

Colour

Printed in shades from purple to red, often arising from changes between ordinary cancellations using black ink and postage paid cancellations using red ink. The colour can affect either the CDS, the wave pattern or both

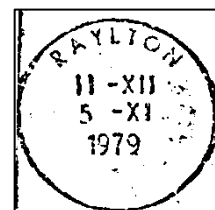

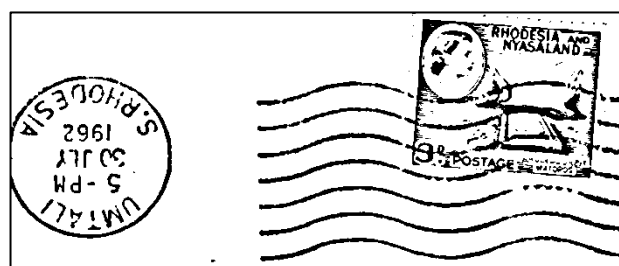

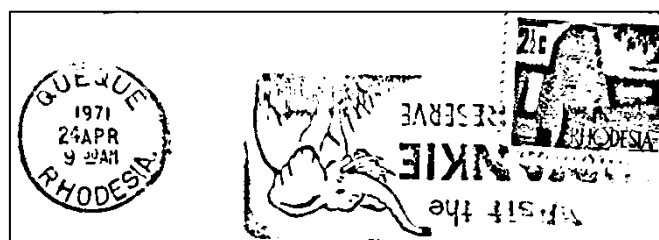

Machine postage paid

These are Postage Paid cancellations applied by machine, particularly to bulk postings, in red ink. Machines normally used the same CDS die as that used for the normal cancellation of adhesives, but with an appropriate obliteration fitted. However, the Universal machine also used a square date stamp inscribed PAID.

The earliest and latest dates of use are recorded, but these must not be taken as implying continuous use. Postage Paid cancellations are set up on the machine as and when required. The obliterations are changed and the ink used is red, not the normal black. Occasionally the Postage Paid settings are inadvertently left in the machine which is then used to cancel ordinary mail.

Krag machine

Krag Postage Paid cancellations use the same Krag CDS as used for cancelling normal postings but with a boxed slogan POSTAGE PAID IN CASH in one of THREE settings.

The lettering is thick, measuring 4½mm high.

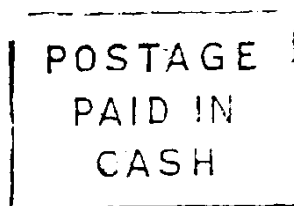

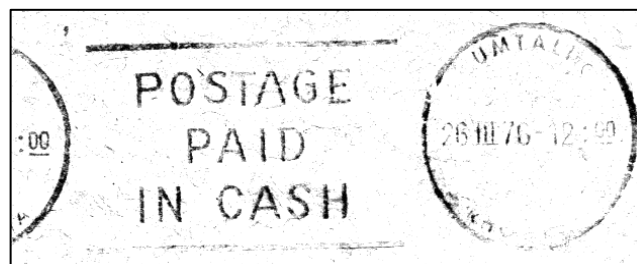

The slogan has frame lines above and below the lettering 23mm apart but does not have vertical lines to complete the rectangle.



Universal machine

The Type U1 CDS dies used for normal machine franking are used with slogans POSTAGE PAID IN CASH or POSTAGE PAID. However, Salisbury used two additional CDS dies. These are square and inscribed PAID and POSTAGE PAID and are used with several slogans.

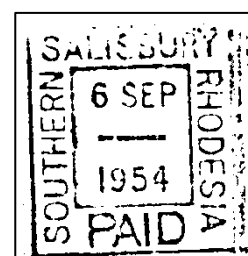

The third line is either blank, a horizontal line or the amount paid. The order of these elements can vary.

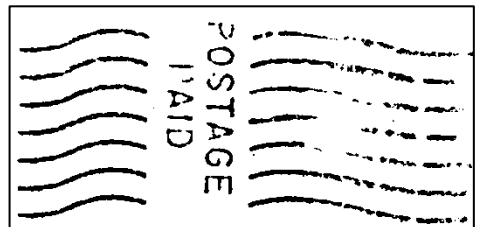

In the type W3b wave pattern, the centre wave block is replaced with a block with the words POSTAGE PAID reading UP or DOWN, reflecting the way the centre block was fitted.

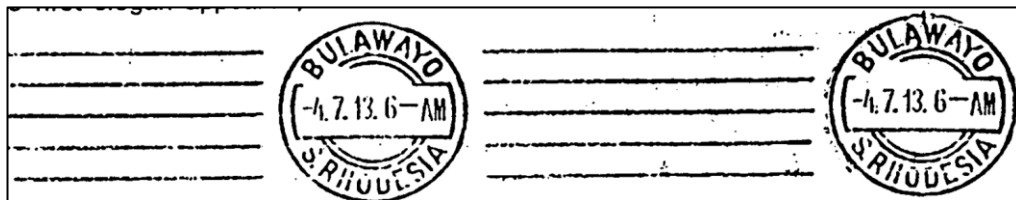
Machine cancellations consist of two parts, the CDS and the obliteration which is a slogan, a message (postage paid, returned letter office), a straight line pattern or a wave pattern.

Krag machine

The design of the Krag machine produces multiple strikes of the obliteration pattern.

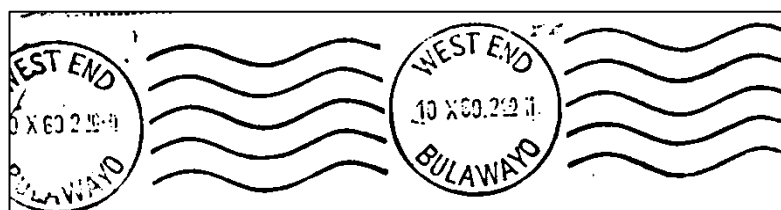
TYPE WK1

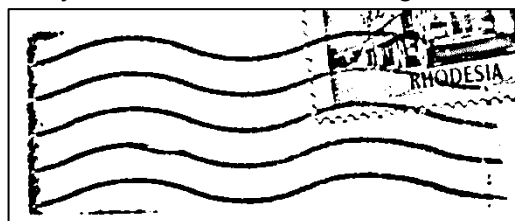
Universal machine

The design of the Universal Machine produces a single strike of the obliteration pattern. The obliteration block can be fitted either way. When fitting a slogan, this can result in an inverted slogan which is easily identified. However, when the obliteration is a wave it is immaterial which way it is fitted. Fitted one way, the wave begins UP; fitted the other way, the wave begins DOWN. In the case of the three-segment waves, each segment can be fitted either way, so that the wave can start UP or DOWN while the centre segment, independently, can also be UP or DOWN, as can the third element. This also explains why 'POSTAGE PAID' in Type W3b reads UP sometimes and DOWN at other times.

Because each wave type can start UP or DOWN, collectors may be interested in collecting both.

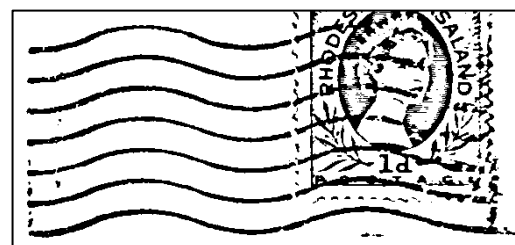

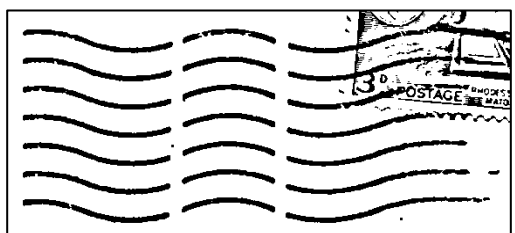

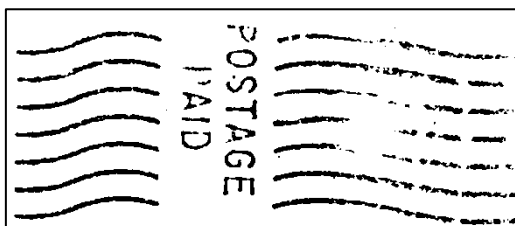

Hand roller cancellations

Hand rollers were introduced in 1963. They are designed to apply a continuous impression on packets and parcels that are too large for Universal machine cancellers though they have been seen used on registered and ordinary mail.

The roller CDS is 27-28mm in diameter and at first sight might be confused with a Krag impression. However, whereas the wave pattern on the Krag machine is horizontal to the CDS, it runs vertically on a roller.

Several of the smaller post offices were issued with rollers as evidenced by an official 1979 date of mutilation and these have been recorded in the Post Office Mutilations. However, as no roller cancellations have been recorded, it is probable that they were never put into use.

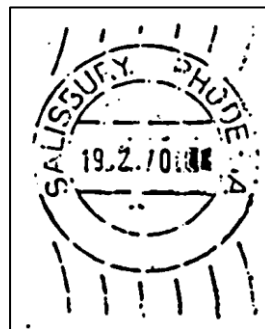

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

For anyone wishing to have the downloaded document printed and wire bound, the complication is that six pages are landscape format, so it is advisable to print the document in stages: -

This is an A4 size document.

Pages 1-2 Print both sides, colour, portrait, on light card

Pages 3-58 Print both sides, black and white, portrait

Pages 59-64 Print both sides, black and white, landscape. Select 'flip on the long edge'.

Page 65-66 Print both sides, black and white, portrait.

Add a transparent plastic sheet at the front.

Add a light white card page to the back.

Select 21-hole punch holes

Select 9/10mm silver (my preference) wire spiral binding coil
