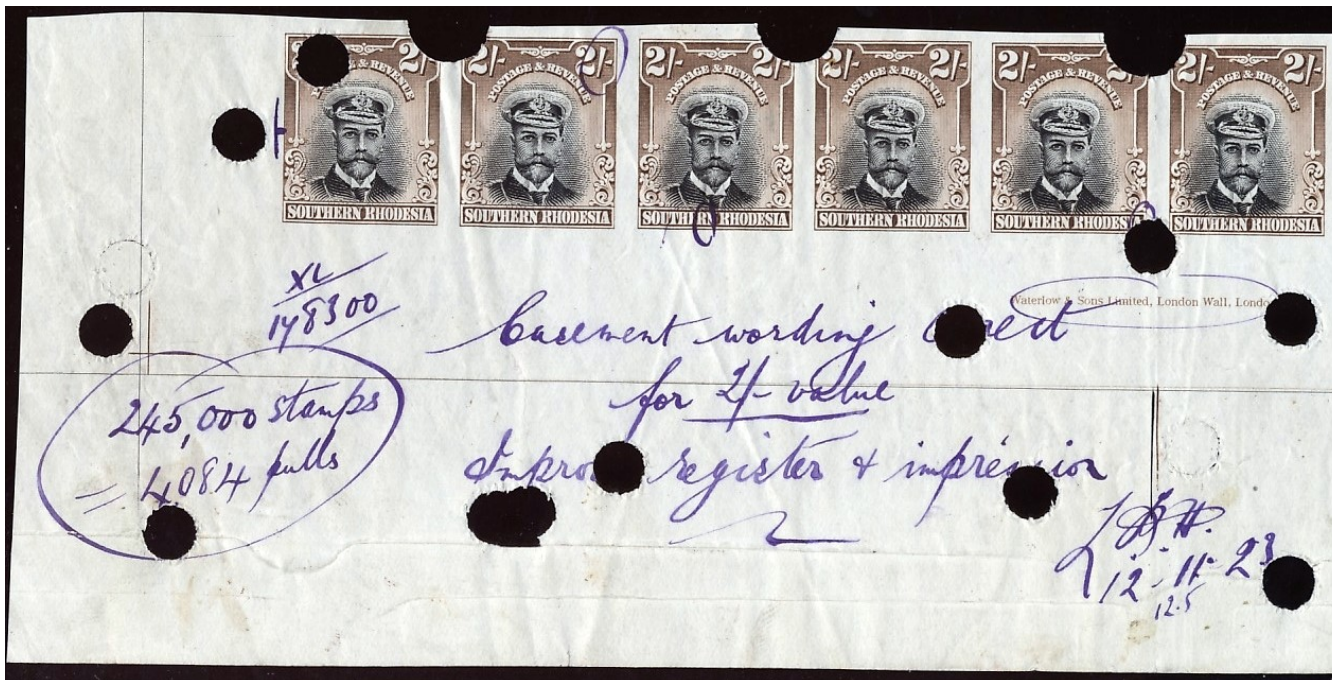


Plates 35047 and 35078

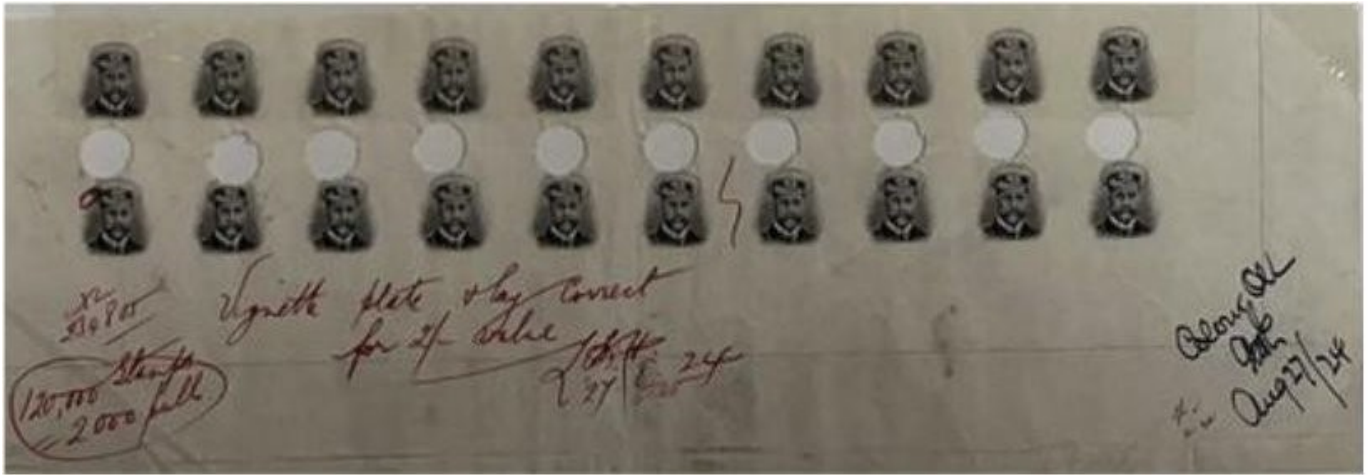
There were 5 sheets. The top 2 rows and the bottom row of the imperforate headplate remained; there were 2 imperforate combined sheets, numbered respectively 188,108 and 56 and 188,109 and 24. The former is endorsed "XL 178,300. Casement wording correct for 2/- value. Improve register + impression. LFH 12.11.23 12.5 245,000 stamps = 4084 pulls"; the latter "Border color OK 19.11.23". The perforated sheet was marked "OK 17.11.23" and the file copy "178,300. 17.10.23 245,000 stamps".

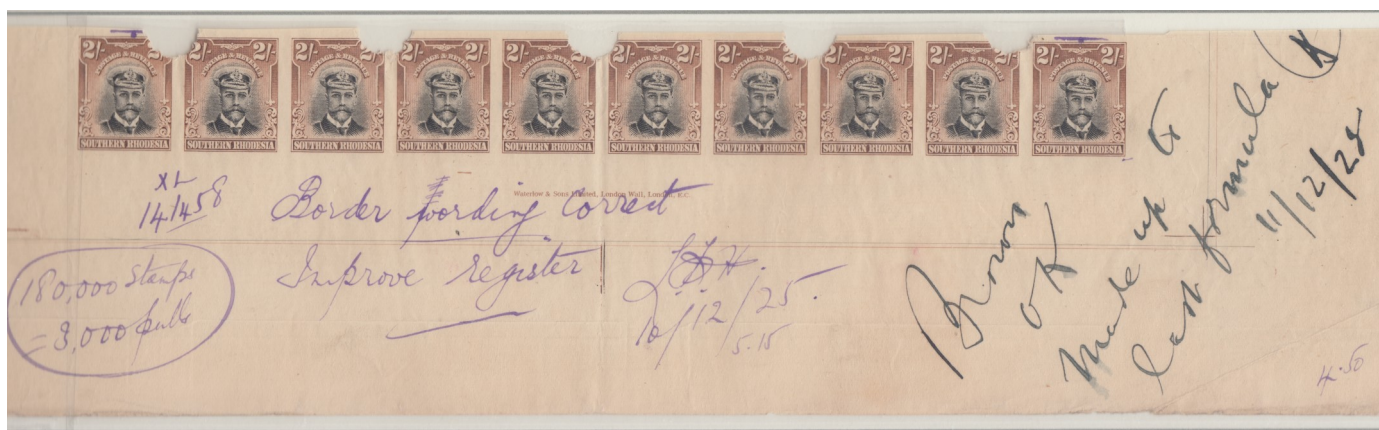
There are 5 sheets in the Archives, but only the bottom 2 rows of the combined imperforate sheet, and the top 2 rows of the standard for examination sheet remained. The file copy was represented by the usual 33 stamps.

There were 3 sheets in the Archives, the vignette sheet being badly discoloured. The combined sheet bore the usual endorsements, with in addition "Brown O.K. Make up to last formula". The file copy had 4 missing at the beginning, and contained 29 stamps when examined.

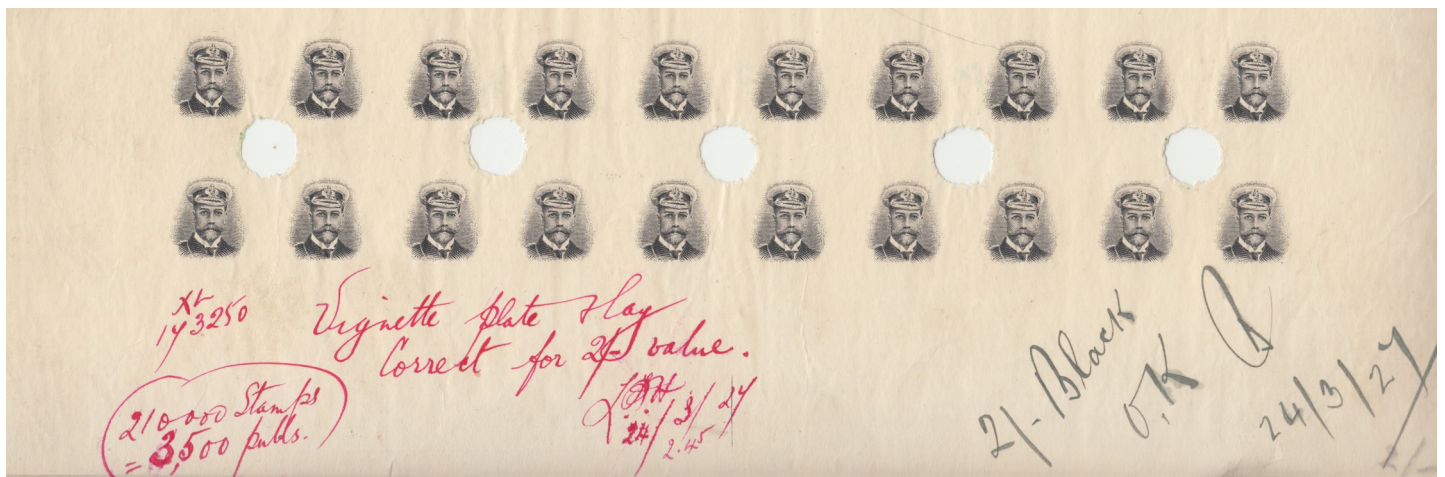
27th May 1926 Printing

3 sheets were retained, but only the bottom 2 rows of the vignette and combined imperforate sheets remained. The information from the endorsements is noted above. Only 13 stamps of the file copy remained.

5th April 1927 Printing
Order No.173250 Print Qty. 210,000



3 sheets were retained, and the complete sheets of the imperforate vignette and combined proofs remained. These contained the usual endorsements and the information is summarised in the table. Large punch holes obliterate the registration marks. The file copy contained 33 stamps.
