St Kitts Nevis Anguilla was one of the few countries that followed Britain's lead in declaring Rhodesia's post UDI stamps as "illegal". Were these covers an unsuccessful attempt to get postage due applied in St Kitts and Nevis?

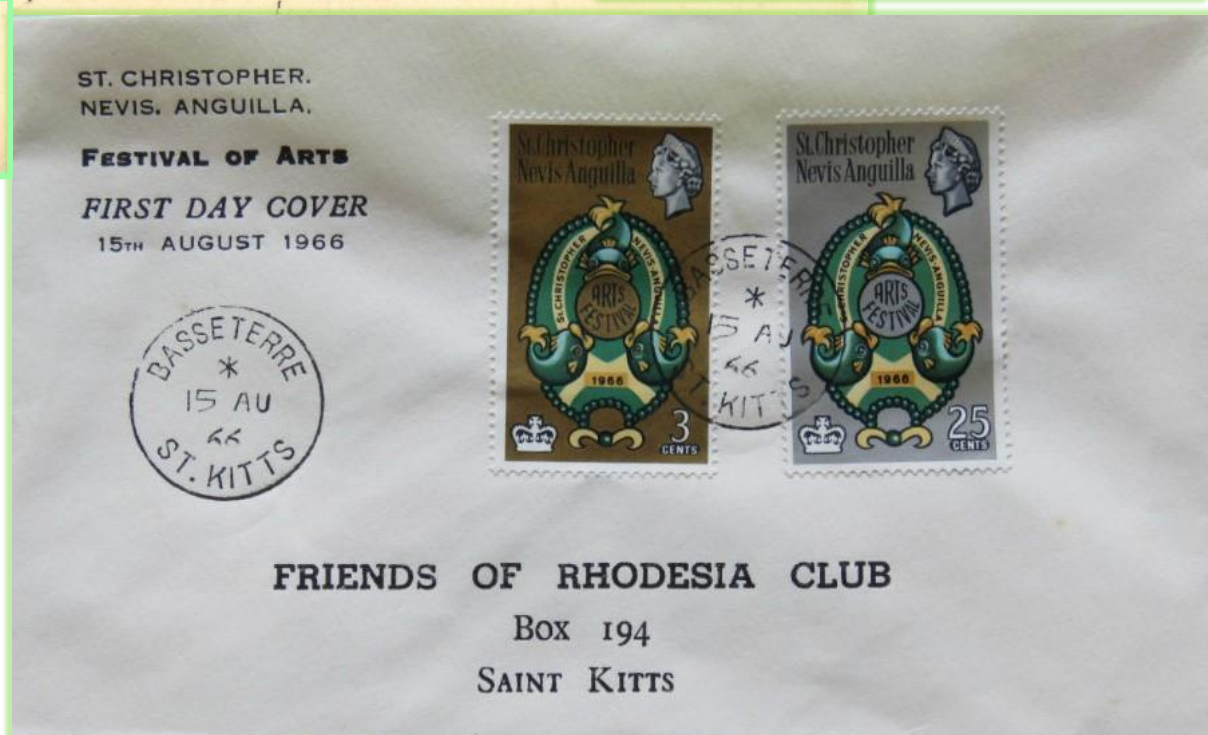


An untaxed 1968 cover posted from USA with Rhodesian Independence overprints to Mr Stevens on St Kitts.
