

# LARGE "P.B.C." CENSOR HANDSTAMP



The Large "P.B.C." (Passed by Censor) handstamp was applied by the Salisbury Censor Office during the "Opening Period" of WWII civil censorship. In use Sep 8, 1939 - Nov 2, 1940.

*Latest Reported Date Large "P.C.B." handstamp*

Large "P.B.C." censor stamp – incoming. Athens, Greece to Salisbury, canceled 2 11 40.  
"P.B.C." censor stamp applied upon receipt

## NO PERIOD VARIETY

P B C.

Large "P B C." variety  
- no periods

Exhibitor's census established variety as not a later "state" but separate handstamp used concurrently with "P.B.C." handstamp with periods..

1 of 4 reported Large "P C B." handstamps  
– no periods.



Large "P B C. (no periods) variety censor stamp - to Maryland, machine canceled Salisbury, 28 SEP / 1940.
