

A Stagecoach from Lomagundi.

This printed colour postcard, captioned "Salisbury and Bulawayo Coach, 1900.", was posted from Lomagundi on 18th February 1909 to England. Published by Strachan & Co., Salisbury (circa 1908) using a "posed" photograph of the stagecoach in front of the Zeederberg Coach Office in Salisbury.



By 1902, the transport of mail by Stagecoach between Salisbury and Bulawayo had been replaced by Mail Train. Overseas mail went onwards to Cape Town.

On 1st December, 1909, Lomagundi was renamed SINOIA.
