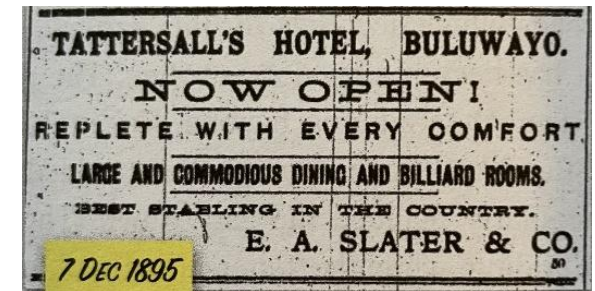


TATTERSALL'S HOTEL, BULAWAYO 1898

Statement of Account rendered by EA Slater & Co. Tattersall's Hotel (later the Selborne Hotel), P.O.Box 36, Bulawayo. The statement dated 1st March 1898 is addressed to "The Sanitary Board" for Horse grass, forage and horse rup supplied between June and December 1897. The account has been **signed**, certified correct and allocated to the Stable Account by Town Superintendent **R. Mainwaring**, the first Bulawayo Sanitary Board Secretary, who was "*much despised by residents for his dogged insistence in enforcing town regulations.*" The account for £24 0s 0d was paid in full on 8th March 1898.

Bulawayo was declared a Municipality on 26th October 1897, part of the celebrations relating to the arrival of the first through train from the South on 19th October 1897.
