Introduction

Brief History of the Waterlow Study Circle

The Waterlow Study Circle ("WSC") was formed as a result of a meeting in London on 20th June, 1981, called by Ray Keach, and attended by 15 interested philatelists. These 15 became the Founder Members of the WSC. In addition, 3 Study Circles, Belgian Congo, Belgium and Rhodesian, supported the idea, and other Study Circles have subsequently joined.

The purpose of the WSC was to provide a forum for the study of the work of Waterlows and to enable an exchange of ideas on this subject to take place between different groups interested in Waterlows.

Perhaps the main reason why it was thought necessary to set up such a Study Circle was that the printers had ceased to exist as a separate company and most of the records had been lost during the last war.

Membership is open to individuals and Study Circles, and at June 1985 there were 45 members (including 8 Study Circles). The annual subscription was £6 (plus airmail supplement for overseas) until 1994/5 when it became £8 with £4 for airmail. The membership at 1993 was 51 (45 individuals, 6 Study Circles), and currently (September 1998) it is individuals and 6 Study Circles

The first Chairman of the WSC in 1981 was Ray Keach, with Colin Hoffman as Secretary/Treasurer and Editor; Colin Fraser took over as Secretary/Treasurer in 1982, and David Hubbard as Editor in 1983, a position he has now held for fifteen years.

Colin Fraser remained Secretary until June 1992 when he was posted to New York. In January 1993 Noel Lyons became Secretary for a short period and the post then became vacant until Derek Weston was elected in June 1995. He only held office for a short period and the post was vacant again until Alan Green became Secretary-elect in January 1998 pending his election in May 1998. During various periods when the WSC had no Secretary the Chairman Alec Turner provided the necessary cover and fulfilled both roles – and that of acting Treasurer – during his term of office as Chairman (1993 to-date).

The separate post of Treasurer was created in 1987 when John Peters was elected, a post he retained for ten years. In May 1997 Roger Lawson was elected Treasurer, but was posted overseas shortly after and had to relinquish the position which was filled by Alec Turner until May 1998 when Colin Hoffman became Treasurer.

The Chairmen of the WSC initially held office for two year periods; following Ray Keach (1981-83) Geoffrey Wood was Chairman for 1983-85, Colin Hoffman 1985-87, Stanley Cross Rudkin 1987-88, John Peters 1988-91, and Jack Ince 1991-93. Alec Turner became Chairman in January 1993 when Jack Ince went to live in Canada. In July 1992 Ray Keach had accepted the role of Vice Chairman pending Jack Ince's move to Canada, so as to hold that office until the 1993 AGM. Ray has remained as Vice Chairman since July 1992. At the 14th AGM in June 1995 it was agreed that the Chairman might serve for five years from date of election and subject to being re-elected annually.

Initially it was thought that the WSC might be only a "limited life study circle" and that after a few meetings, it would have been dissolved. Happily this has not proved to be the case, although in recent times the WSC has been somewhat less active than in earlier times.

Brief History of Waterlows

In 1810 James Waterlow opened a shop in Birchin Lane selling copies of legal documents produced by lithography. The firm printed its first stamps in 1852, for British Guiana.

The business expanded, and the four sons of James Waterlow, Alfred, Walter, Sydney and Albert, joined the partnership, and branches were opened at Westminster and London Wall.

James died in 1876, and the firm became a limited liability company. In 1877 there was a family dispute and Alfred, the eldest son, and his sons and Alfred Thomas Layton, formed Waterlow Bros. & Layton retaining the Birchin Lane premises. The other brothers, under the Managing Directorship of Sir Sydney (as he had become after being Lord Mayor of London in 1872) continued Waterlow & Sons Limited ("W. & S."), operating from London Wall, Finsbury Market and other factories. In 1887, on the death of Alfred, Waterlow Bros & Layton became a company ("W.B.& L.").

In 1920 the two companies amalgamated, thus ending 43 years of close competition.

In 1932 disaster struck the Company in the form of a House of Lords judgement to pay the Bank of Portugal £610,392, and it has been said the Company never fully recovered from this drain on its resources.

In 1952 the Company celebrated "A Century of Stamp Production" and a booklet by that name, written by L.N. and M. Williams (44 pages) is indeed a tribute to a proud record. Unfortunately, although listing all the stamp production of the company over the previous 100 years, the list did not distinguish which was W.& S. and which W.B.& L. However the range of customers was most impressive.

At the end of 1960 the assets of Waterlow & Sons Limited were acquired by De La Rue & Co. Ltd., and subsequently material from the Waterlows archives has become available, the sample stamps in the 1960's, the file copies and record sheets from about 1975 and the die proofs in the mid 1980's.

Purpose of this Bibliography

The purpose is twofold: it is to incorporate an index of the Journal of the Waterlow Study Circle, and to list literature published elsewhere which has particular information about Waterlows.

The WSCJ Index has always been produced on a cumulative basis and the index is designed to be produced separately for use by members of the WSC. It can be removed from this bibliography and inserted with the bound volumes of the Journal if required. But it can - and should - do more than this.

It can provide a guide to the information about Waterlows that has appeared in WSCJ; the basic entries have therefore been expanded for this purpose. The additional information of necessity has had to be kept brief, but it is hoped that it will be more useful than a simple index - without at the same time losing its usefulness as an index to WSCJ.

The listing of literature published elsewhere is also intended to do more than just provide references; it should provide a guide to the content and scope of this literature to assist the reader in finding information. Such listing, and the detail given, must be somewhat subjective, but it is hoped that in time it will provide a useful source of information about Waterlows and provide a supplement to the Index of WSCJ.

The Compilers

This bibliography began as a joint effort of a number of members of the WSC and any comment from members is welcome.

The Index of the WSCJ is based on the initial indexes produced by Peter Foden, Colin Hoffman (Editor WSCJ 1981 - 83) and the Reverend David Hubbard (Editor WSCJ 1983 to date). The first Index for Year 1 (September 1981 to June 1982) (No's. 1-4) was compiled by Colin Hoffman and Peter Foden, and updated in 1985 for Years 1-4 (September 1981 to March 1985) (No's. 1-13) with the assistance of David Hubbard. Further editions of the Index were produced in 1987 and 1993 by Colin Hoffman who incorporated references to the further Journals which had appeared in the intervals. The 1987 Revised Edition included additional information introduced at the suggestion of members of the WSC.

The listing of literature which has been published elsewhere is based on initial listings of such literature in WSCJ, expanded by additional information. This list, which starts at page 100, is still only in preliminary form, as there must be more items which should be recorded.

The question of categories and classification in the bibliography will require some thought, and the present format may not be entirely satisfactory. However, it will only be possible to decide on this question when a reasonably comprehensive list of published literature has been produced. The indexes to Fundamentals of Philately and the cumulative index to The Philatelist (Robson Lowe 1975), both by James Negus, should be consulted for guidance on this aspect.

NOTES

- (1) The WSCJ initially was indexed every 4 issues, at the end of each year of the life of the WSC, thus Index 1 for Year 1 covered September 1981 to June 1982 (WSCJ 1 - 4), Year 2 was September 1982 to June 1983 (WSCJ 5 - 8), and Year 3 was September 1983 to June 1984 (WSCJ 9 - 12). The first index was followed by the first cumulative index which covers years 1 and 2.

The WSCJ did not appear in September and December 1984, and the next issue was WSCJ 13 in March 1985. A second cumulative index covered WSCJ 1-13. A combined cumulative index and bibliography appeared in March 1987, covering WSCJ 1-17, and a revised edition of "A Waterlow Bibliography" in 1993 covered WSCJ 1-29. This edition covered WSCJ 1-43 and takes us up to July 1998. The WSCJ will be indexed cumulatively from time to time, and the issues so indexed will be specifically noted in the Index heading.

- (2) The pages of WSCJ started at page 1 with the September issue in 1981, 1982 and 1983 and with the March issue in 1985. For 1985 and subsequent years the pages of WSCJ start at page 1 with the first issue in each Calendar Year, except that in 1992 the June issue was numbered in sequence from June 1991, and the December 1992 issue started at page 1. A quick checklist of issue numbers and pages appears overleaf.
- (3) In the listing of Articles, the first major word of each title determines its alphabetical position, unless the name of the country is contained in the title, in which case the article is listed under the country - e.g.

"Waterlow Perforations" - under 'W'

"Waterlow Overprints - China" - under 'China'

Some cross referencing may well be necessary as the list increases. In theory, where an article also deals with a specific aspect of the work of Waterlows, e.g. overprints, it should also be indexed in the section "The Waterlow Questions".

- (4) Each user of the index will find points of difficulty - please report these so that the index can be made as useful as possible.
