

# Liebigs (Rhodesia) Ltd.

## (Bulawayo)

Cancelled at BULAWAYO 1 JAN 46 to New York. Postage including airmail – 3/9d. Liebigs are an international canned meat firm, based in the UK. They received a massive tranche of land near West Nicholson in the 1920s. Until the 1990s their meat canning plant was at West Nicholson – now a ruin.



**The probable route:** By SAA to Durban in Lockheed Loadstars. On the Horseshoe route with BOAC flying boats from Durban to Mombasa via Lourenço Marques, Beira, Mozambique, Dar es Salaam.

**Either 1:** Then across Africa to Lagos, again with BOAC flying boats via Port Bell (Lake Victoria), Stanleyville, Coquilhatville, Leopoldville and Libreville. BOAC then flew to the UK via Accra, Tokaradi, Freetown, Bathurst, Dakar, Port Etienne, Rabat and Lisbon using land planes.

**Or 2:** Along the Nile Valley to Cairo. From Cairo by BOAC landplanes to Malta, Gibraltar and UK.

Red **OAT** (Onward Air Transmission) cachet added in London, and then across the North Atlantic from Foynes with BOAC to New York via Gander and Shediac.
