Two matters to note: almost 50% of all cancels during this time were from Bulawayo and that the European population in Northern Rhodesia was very small, thus cancels are much scarcer.



Different types of postmarks: Double Circle, Square Circle, Triple Circle, Single Circle, Barred Diamonds and Ovals and Skeleton Postmarks



The Skeleton postmarks are a very collectable and rare subset for collectors



Postmarks on a particular value, values or stamp

There is one collector who specialises in postmarks on the 4d Double Head; Northern Rhodesia cancels on the 4d Double Head are very rare – around 10 reported; another collector is attempting to collect a Northern Rhodesia postmark on each value of the Double Head Issue – they are currently one short!

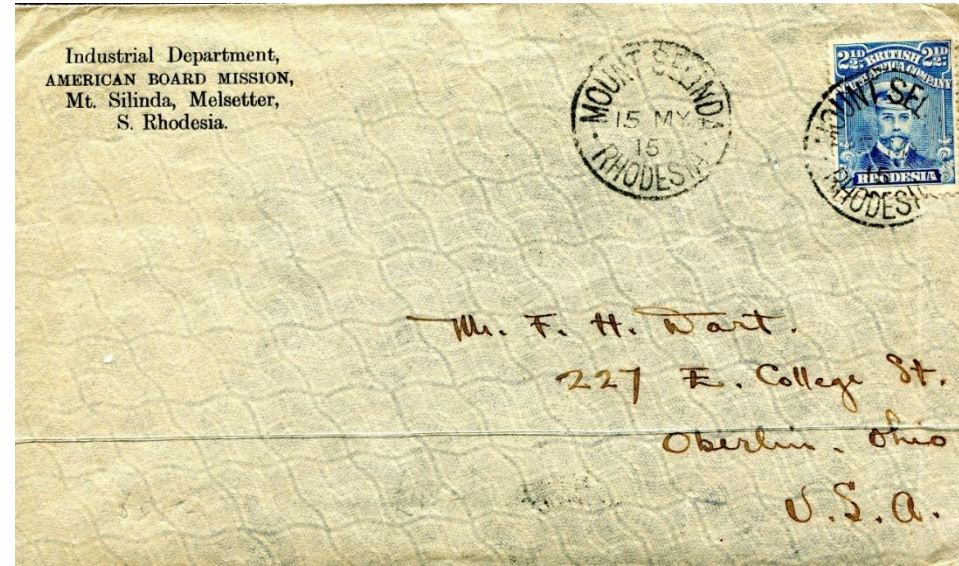

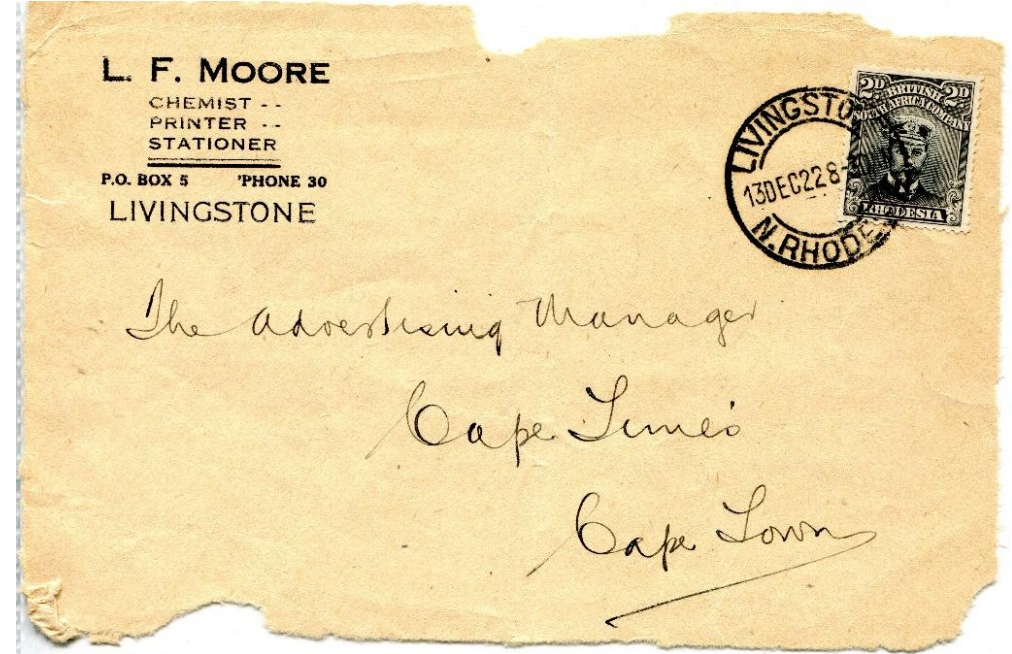

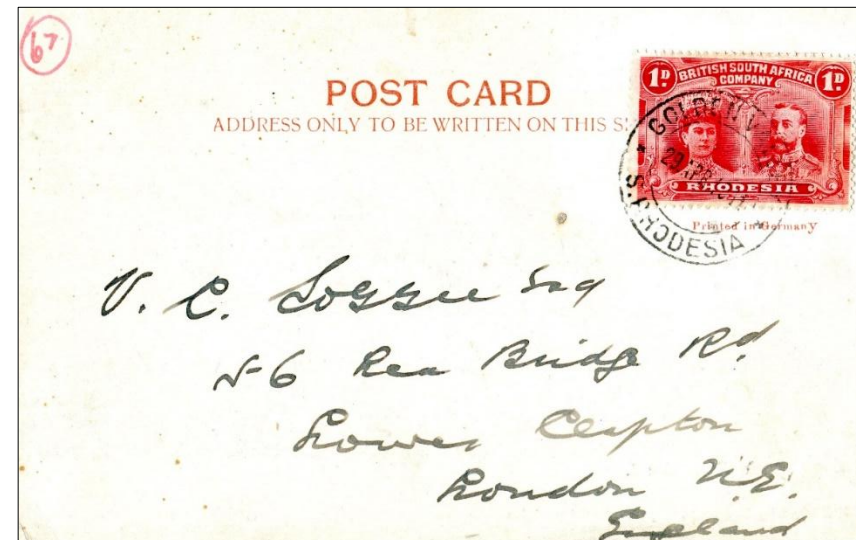

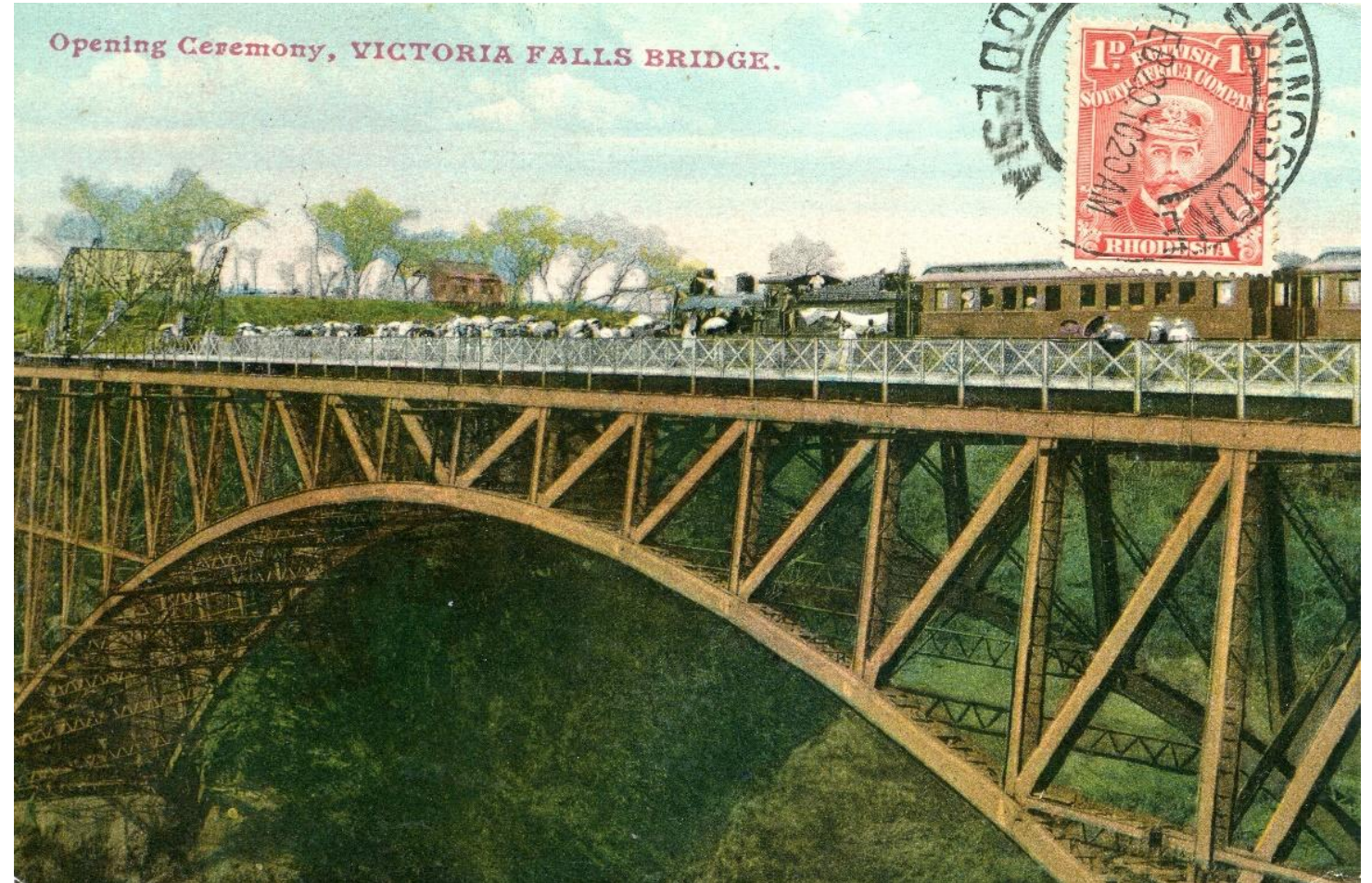

Rarity

A numbers of factors come into play:

- *Rare Cancellor*
- *Rare Post office or Agency due to opening or closing dates or geographical location*
 - *Cancel on a rare stamp*
- *On cover or card increases desirability*
