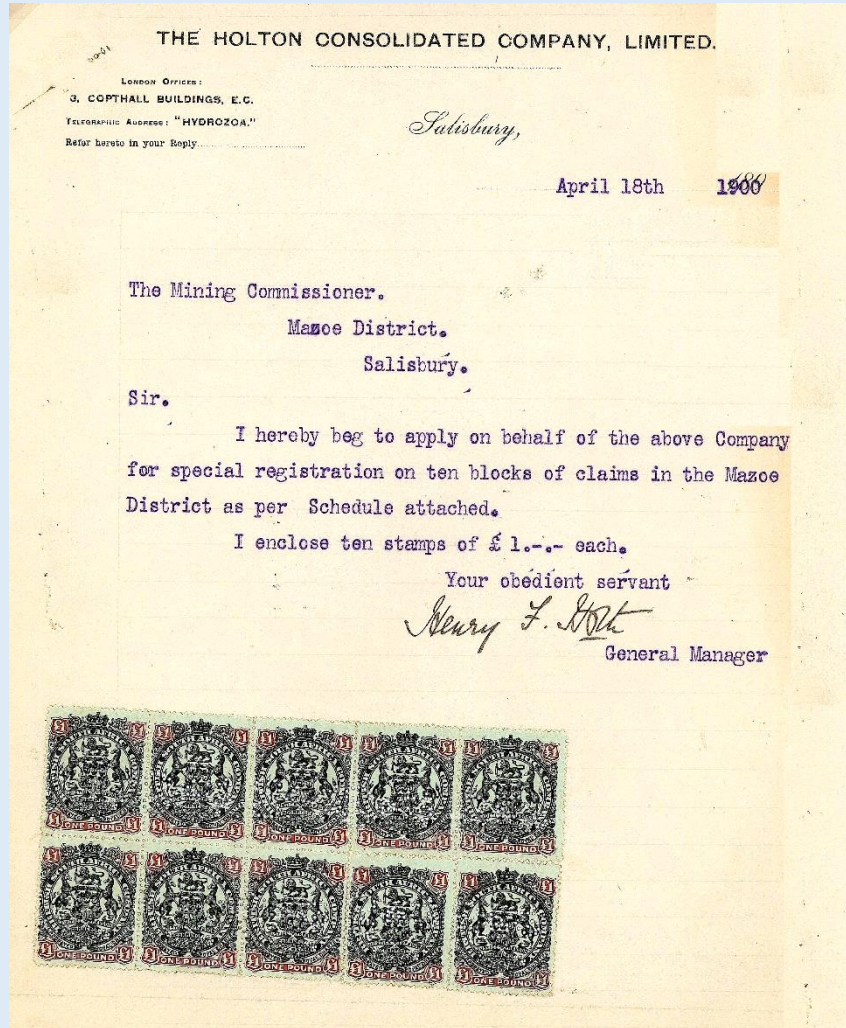
The 1898 Ordinance stated that duplicate Certificates of Registration would be issued at no cost after the loss had been advertised in the Gazette for 30 days. No mention was made that the application would require a payment of 5/- per block as indicated by this application.

The 1903 Ordinance introduced a fee of 5/- per duplicate certificate.

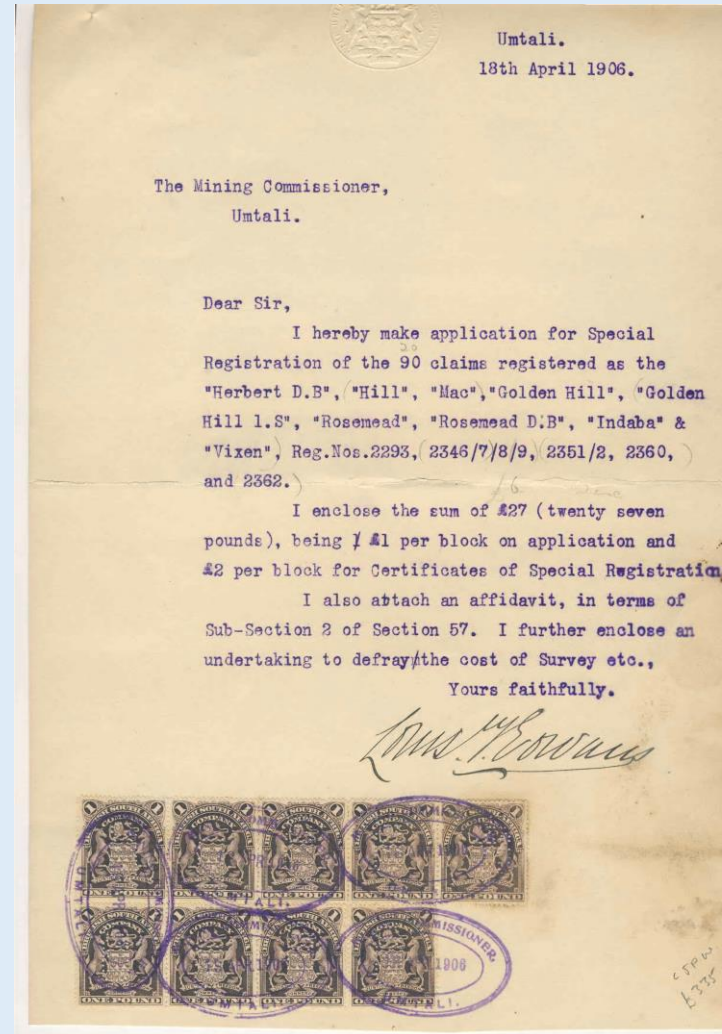

From 1895 a registered holder could apply for a Certificate of Special Registration. This gave the holder an indefeasible title to the location or site i.e. the title could not be forfeited or annulled. The application had to bear a stamp of £1 per block.
